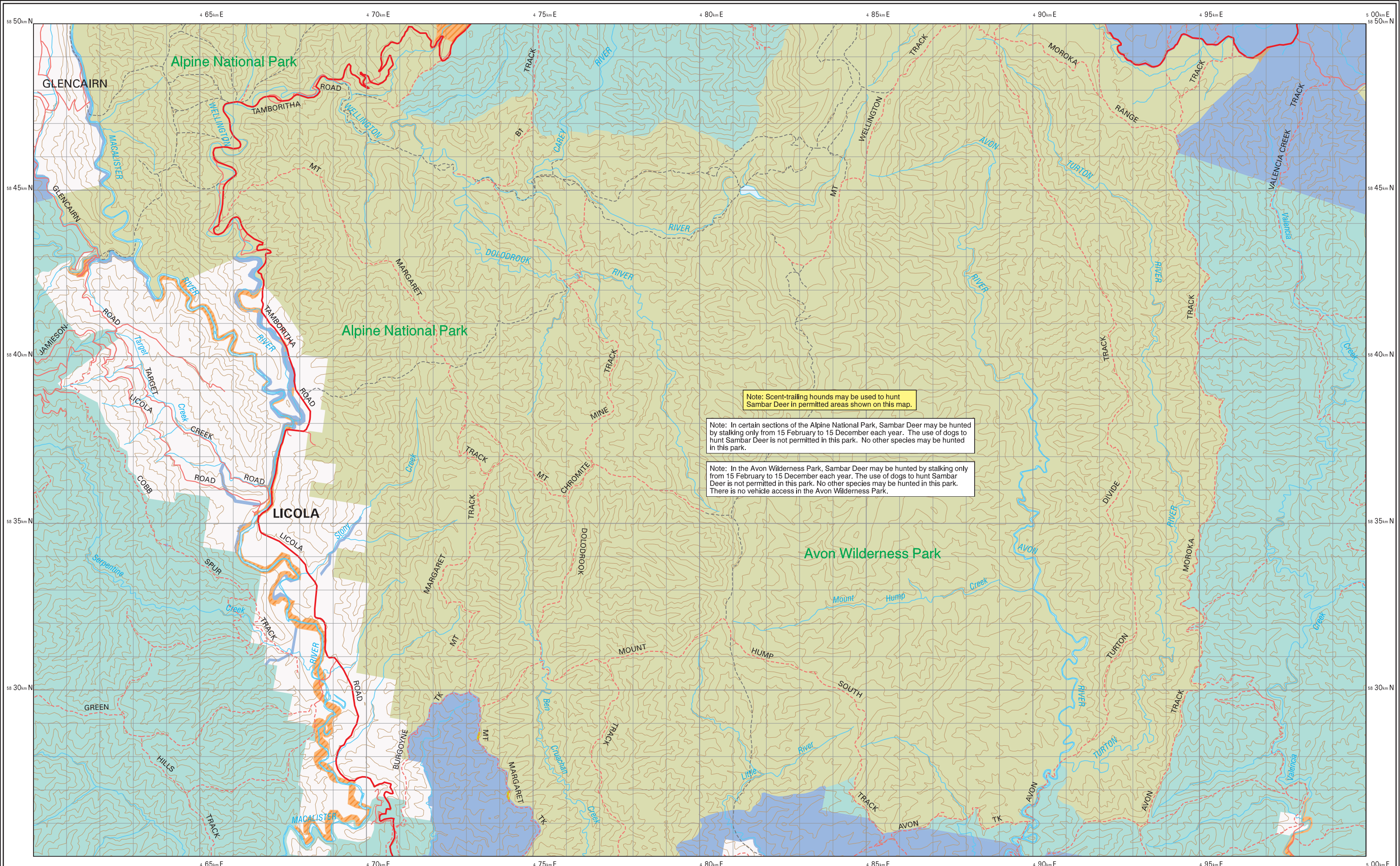




Note: Scent-trailing hounds may be used to hunt Sambar Deer in permitted areas shown on this map.

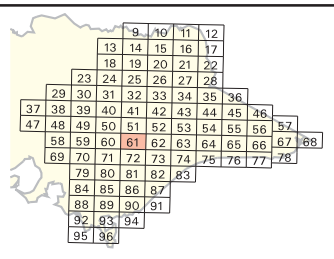
