Do not attend a Checking Station without an appointment.





Please phone a checking station operator to arrange an appointment within 24 hours of harvesting a Hog Deer.

What happens at a checking station?

- Your name, date of birth and Game Licence number are recorded.
- Date, time and location of the take are noted.
- Shoulder height, length and girth of the deer are recorded, and antlers are measured.
- All stags are photographed.
- The reproductive condition of hinds is assessed (if it had a foetus, please bring it to the Checking Station if you can)
- A jawbone is removed so the deer may be aged (to assist jawbone removal place a chock in the mouth if possible)
- Other biological samples may also be taken.
